I have spent a majority of my time since the last board meeting working on the water district mapping project. Morris Coolidge and Mike Batz from NY Rural Water Association spent three days in town acquiring GPS coordinates for hydrants, valves and curb stops that we had located. Over 500 points were logged into a database. I have also been taking photos that mark the curb stops and logging them under the 911 address for the property in the map books. We are about 90% done. Morris will try and return in August to finish up. We have about 20 sites to locate and the airport area to complete. Days have been long, but the information obtained will benefit the water district for many years to come.
